## 3 Kitchen Trends We're Loving Right Now!

✓ Black kitchens ♥ Our new Novus handleless range in Super Matt Jet creates a luxurious atmosphere and elevates the whole look of your kitchen.

✓ Slab splashbacks: increasing the area of your splashback (which would traditionally just cover the space above your hob), involves using a larger piece of rectangular stone to cover the whole area between worktops and wall units. Looks amazing in Calacatta Quartz!

## Let's look at... Downdraft Hoods

*Downdraft hoods and vented hobs are the perfect solution for keeping your kitchen design and sightlines clear. Discreet and quiet, they extract the cooking smells directly at the source but take up some space beneath the worktop.*

*The details...*

*A downdraft cooker hood is a retractable ventilation system that is integrated into the kitchen worktop. It sits beneath the hob, drawing steam, fumes and grease downward.*

*If you are after a sleek look on your kitchen island, a vented cooker hood is a good option. It has a completely flush ventilation system integrated into the middle of the hob, so there is no need for any overhead extractor fan.*
